The Bruno David Gallery offers internships to students of junior-year college level or above, recent graduates, graduate students, postgraduates, and mature professionals pursuing further experience in the arts.

The objective of the internship program is to offer practical art gallery training experience to individuals interested in pursuing careers in the arts and gallery/museum fields. Interns gain a general knowledge and broad understanding of how a contemporary art gallery functions within the context of a well-recognized art gallery. Interns participate in the ongoing work of the gallery and complete specific projects or portions of larger gallery's initiatives. Spring and fall internships require a minimum commitment of 5 hours per week (in addition to participation in the gallery's Opening Nights and installation and de-installation of exhibitions). Summer internships require a minimum commitment of a full day per week (in addition to participation in the gallery's Opening Nights and installation and de-installation of exhibitions). All internships require a commitment of four months. The interns will gain valuable experience in the day-to-day operations of a professional art gallery as well as insight into the workings of the St. Louis art community.

The interns will be responsible for assisting the gallery staff with:

- Welcoming visitors and answering questions about the current exhibition
- Handling and storing artworks
- Preparing materials for monthly exhibitions
- Updating the gallery inventory and mailing lists
- Creating Art Publications in *In Design* and *Photoshop*
- Other assorted tasks

Interns will be compensated in the form of academic credit. This internship is open to both undergraduate and graduate students and is ideal for those considering a career in the Visual Arts or Art History, although all applicants will be considered.
