The art space is open from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Wednesday through Saturday, so that'll give you ample time to check out Thomas Sleet's mixed-media sculptural paintings, selected prints from Island Press (including works by Chakaia Booker,

Juan Sanchez and others), German artist Ingo Baumgarten's small paintings and the video art of Ella Gant. Admission to the Bruno David Gallery is free, and the exhibits remain up through Saturday, January 12.
