Bruno David Gallery Announces Its February 2008 Exhibition

FOUR ACES: Large-Scale Prints from Four Universities

Bruno David Gallery is pleased to announce the exhibit *FOUR ACES: Large-Scale Prints from Four Universities*. The works exhibited are from 48 graduate students and faculty members of **Washington University in St. Louis - Sam Fox School of Design & Visual Arts; Louisiana State University - College of Art and Design, University of Texas - Austin;** and **University of Wisconsin - Madison.**

For several years, LSU, UT, and UW have put on similar art exhibitions. This is the first year a fourth university has been included. Washington University in St. Louis seemed an obvious choice for the fourth university as Carmon Colangelo, printmaker and dean of the Sam Fox School of Design and Visual Art, is an alumnus of the LSU School of Art.

These four top universities are linked because so few art schools have the facilities and equipment to produce large-format prints. The exhibit will display various printmaking mediums, including screen-printing, digital printing, collagraph, and relief printing.
